12 Ways to Get the Best Results over the Phone



1. Identify yourself first. People like to know to whom they are speaking.
2. Be polite. You will get better information and results.
3. Be positive. Always assume that the person can help you. If he/she cannot, ask for a referral to another source.
4. Be prepared. Write down your questions ahead of time.
5. Be specific and explain why you need the information or assistance.
6. If you know what you want, ask for it, not for what you assume the organization has.
7. If you are unsure of what you need, ask for help formulating your questions.

8. Ask for specific brochures or pamphlets.
9. Ask for a sample of newsletters to be mailed to you. These can be a great source of information.
10. Be persistent. If you do not get the information you need from the person who answers the phone, politely ask to be transferred to another department or that person's superior.
11. Consider calling more than one organization. Sometimes organizations have biases or vested interest that may influence their point of view.
12. Say thank you!
