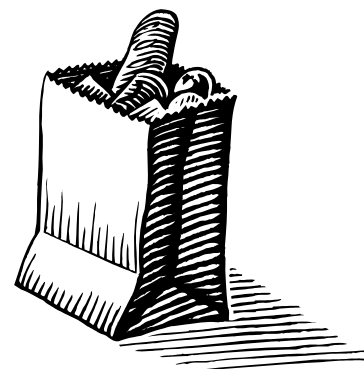


# Food Assistance
